

Survey of Voters in Montana

Topline Report – October 7, 2020

Clout Research is a national public opinion research firm based in Dublin, Ohio, and serving clients in business, politics, government, media, and the non-profit sector. It conducted a telephone survey of registered voters statewide in Montana regarding U.S. Constitutional rights and issues related to the Coronavirus. The survey was conducted October 1-5, 2020 and included interviews with 820 respondents in both landline and mobile phone households. The survey carried a confidence interval of 95% and a margin of error of +/- 3.42 percentage points.

Q1.
